

## Election Committee for the StuPa election in Spring 2024 wanted!

The Student Parliament of the BTU (StuPa) is the highest decision-making body of the student body. It is re-elected annually by you, the students—these elections are organized by an election commission (WaKo) that is independent of the parliament.

The tasks of the WaKo include the planning, organization and implementation of the election. The election and the possibility of candidacy must be advertised in time at the university, which requires, among other things, the creation and distribution of posters, flyers and other advertising material. Of course, social media can be employed as well to inform as many students as possible of the upcoming elections—creativity in the advertising measures is always welcome!

After the election, the election committee invites to and hosts the constituent meeting of the newly elected StuPa. This also includes the preparation of proper minutes. The follow-up of the election also includes recording the collected positive and negative experiences and recommendations for the next election commission in a textual final report.

Of course, all this is done in compliance with the statutes and regulations of the student body, especially its election regulations.
